Kim Crone, Ph.D. is a psychologist who has been specializing in the counseling and education of patients experiencing infertility for over 15 years. Patients have the option of seeing Dr. Crone at CARS

or at her office in Canton, CT where she provides cognitive behavioral counseling to help patients manage and understand the emotional aspects of infertility treatment. In addition to providing supportive counseling, she offers her patients instruction in mind-body techniques to promote effective coping with the stress of treatment. She also conducts psychoeducational consultations with patients considering third-party reproduction, including donor sperm, donor egg and/or the use of a gestational carrier and she guides patients in deciding if third party reproduction is right for them. Dr. Crone's goal is to help her patients feel stronger, take back a sense of control of their lives, and have the energy to persevere with treatment for as long as they choose to do so.

Dr. Crone sees patients at the Center or at her private office in Canton.
